Jumeirah Al Naseem A Cool and Contemporary Beachside Retreat

Jumeirah Al Naseem invites the outdoors in. Lush gardens edge the sandy beach, providing pockets of privacy and peacefulness. The 435 rooms and suites are open and spacious, accented with Arabian touches delivering a strong sense of place. From the balconies and extended terraces, there are spectacular views of the sea, the resort's landscaped gardens, swimming pools and Jumeirah Burj Al Arab.

- Behind the front desk there is a poem written in Arabic calligraphy. The author is the Ruler of Dubai and Vice President of the UAE, H.H Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum
- Emirati artist Mattar Bin Lahej was commissioned to create four statement art pieces in the hotel. He grew up playing football where the hotel now resides
- Jumeirah Al Naseem is home to the Turtle Rehabilitation Lagoon
- There are 14 different species of palm trees dotted across the gardens and courtyards of the hotel
- The light interior design is inspired by sand dunes, blue skies, sea breeze and Dubai's heritage of pearl diving and bedouin traditions
- 3 business centre boardrooms
- Super-soft mattresses are crafted by Hypnos, the official supplier to Buckingham Palace





Design and Interiors

Jumeirah Al Naseem was conceived by its developers, Mirage Leisure and Development, to become a cousin, not a brother, of the rest of Madinat Jumeirah. To be more contemporary and modern, yet still retaining its scale, being a resort, and belonging to the same family. It represents the transition between the traditional and the very modern. This is evident through the display of contemporary art by Emirati artist Matar bin Lahej. A polished steel caravan of running camels welcomes guests to the hotel's grand entrance, and other inspiring pieces adorn the lobby area. Jumeirah Al Naseem was designed to invite the outdoors in, with carefully landscaped gardens by acclaimed landscape designer Bill Bensley. More than 1,000 palm trees from 14 species edge the sandy beach, providing pockets of privacy and peacefulness. The inspiration for the light interior design comes from Dubai's heritage of pearl diving and Bedouin traditions, as well as the natural elements of sand dunes, blue skies, and sea breeze. Spectacular views of Jumeirah Burj Al Arab can be enjoyed from many of the large guest rooms and terraces, configured to adapt to guests' needs and accented with modern Arabian touches.





Home to the most private offering of Madinat Jumeirah are the newly re-imagined Malakiya Villas. With its extensive contemporary refurbishment, designed in the style of Old Arabia and built to represent the paragon of Arabian splendour amidst the winding waterways and verdant gardens of Madinat Jumeirah. Malakiya translates as Royal and is an epitome of luxury comprising seven independent villas that are elegantly designed to connect guests to the true Arabian opulence, heritage and hospitality.

A Story Inspired by the Emirati Heritage

Dubai's rich heritage is celebrated in the elegant design of our new Malakiya Villas. Inspired by nature's bounty, the Dana Villa references Dubai's strong roots in pearl diving, while the Zahra Villa is a symbol of the city's diverse flora. The golden dunes surrounding the city have inspired our Mahra Villa, a symbol of the grace and elegance of young Arabian horses, while the Tala Villa provides a cool retreat much like the small palm tree it is named after. The Ayla and Sama Villas, meaning moonlight and sky, are an ode to some of the region's most renowned literature and poetry, inspired by starry evenings in the desert. For VIP guests seeking a regal retreat, the Royal Malakiya Villa provides an opulent haven for a memorable holiday.



Design and Interiors

Jumeirah Dar Al Masyaf villas are modelled on the Arabian House. Whether a room is facing the sea or the waterway, guests enjoy complete privacy amid the vicinity of a larger resort life. The design of the property is reminiscent of the style of classic Arabian architecture. Each property is elegantly charming, featuring mosaic fountains, a wind tower and palm trees for an aura of peaceful relaxation. Each Arabian House is centred around a majlis – a cosy courtyard space with a private swimming pool. The authentic, charming majlis and courtyard each house a traditional mosaic fountain nestled within palm trees, welcoming guests with the soothing and magical aura of serenity.

Jumeirah Mina Al Salam is the heart of our sprawling resort. The spacious 291 guest rooms and suites have been beautifully refurbished, with private balconies overlooking the ocean, offering authentic Arabian experiences with family friendly service. - The hotel's guest rooms were beautifully refurnished in 2022, with private balconies overlooking the sea
- Jumeirah Mina Al Salam was designed to be the 'port of entry' hotel - the stopover place and gathering point for travellers and merchants from the four corners of the earth
- J Club at Jumeirah Mina Al Salam is one of Dubai's biggest and the best luxury hotel gyms with state-of-the-art equipment, exercise classes, a 25 metre indoor swimming pool, three squash courts and four tennis courts





Design and Interiors

Jumeirah Mina Al Salam is a homage to the seafaring heritage of the UAE, its name the 'Harbour of Peace' is the guiding philosophy that leads the design inspiration. True to its name it is a wonderful haven for gentle and charming luxury. Upon entering the lobby, a water feature covered in fresh flower petals awaits, above it a replica of an antique nautical map of the region, to instantly arouse a blissful harbour. Enveloping the guest instantly to the nautical escape that welcomes them. One of the key features of the design of the greater location are the three kilometre of waterways. A magical creek filled with natural seawater, pumping to keep it authentically fresh and aligned with the flowing tides. These waterways are also the arteries interlinking the resort. In the Arab world, water has always been a symbol of wealth. Water was scarce for the Bedouins of the desert and the value placed on it is deeply ingrained in the culture and architecture of the Arabic countries. This provides a luxury story interwoven into the resort. Khuan Chew was the interior designer for this hotel, her favourite feature is "The Harry Potter staircase" that leads guests from the waterways to the hotel. This staircase was intricately carved from hard wood to specific design drawings by craftsmen and installed piece by piece in situ.


